The comparison between emotional and informational support: A case study of Shiou Faction in Taiwan

And had successfully opened up the Guangdong lions market in Taiwan. The successful publicity organized a group that consists of 15 members naming themselves the Shiou Faction Lion Dance in Taiwan. This paper will focus on two different topics, one is about the idea of the three types of triadic reciprocal determinism and another one is about the four aspects of social support.

Therefore, to find out the result, this paper will conduct a semi-structured interview method as well as use social network analysis to conclude the data. The reason for using social network analysis is because a social network is an interactive relationship between members of a group, in which members are each other's external environment, based on the interaction between people, and the establishment of common values between groups [2]. Additionally, the main purpose of this paper is to use social network analysis data to prove that knowing the understanding of the triadic

The social cognitive learning theory emphasizes the idea of the three elements of triadic reciprocal determinism (Personal Factors, Behavioural Factors, and Environmental Factors). That can be found in Table 1, which described the details of what the three types of triadic reciprocal determinism mean.




Figure 1 Triadic Reciprocal Determination through the Dynamic Interplay of Personal, Behavioral, and Environmental Factors [4]

Together, [6] classified social support into four aspects: emotional support, evaluative (appraisal) support, informational support, and instrumental support. This can be viewed in Table 2 [6], had categorized the four different types of social support accordingly to definitions.

# 4. Methodology

To investigate, this paper will conduct a semi-structured interview, with a total of 15 members coming from the dragon and lion troupe. During the process, there will be 14 males and 1 female in total. After gathering all the answers, it will be converted into a single 15 x 15 matrix format. Which will later be using SPSS version 22 for users to analyze and calculate the basic questions. Covered the gender, annual income of the dragon and lion troupe, license, the position whether the head of the group is full-time or not, and lastly the average and standard deviation of the number of permanent disciples and seniority.

Furthermore, to insist on the difference between emotional support and informational support, this paper will be using a social network diagram to show the relationship of each member. With the help of social network analysis, as the social support of external factors, using the social network method to analyze can also observe the social situation from a new perspective. [8] Pointed out that the analysis through the social network methods opens up a new way of analysis for social cognitive theory.

### 5. Results and discussion

After conducting a semi-structured interview, this paper used SPSS version 22 to analyze the data. Table 3, showed the gender distribution of the subjects in this study was 14 males and 1 female. With a total of having 15.13 average annual income, with a standard deviation of 8.38.

With an average income distribution of the dragon and lion troupe below 200,000 there are 5 people (33.3%), 6 people having around 200,000 to 500,000 (40%), and over 500,000 there are only 4 people (26.7%). It is known that the salary level is less equal. The distribution of whether there are professional licenses is mainly divided into 12 people with own a license and only 3 people who do not own a license. Moreover, the average number of permanent disciples they have is 10 people. Those are the people who are working as full- time, and 5 people who work part-time with a total of 33.3 percent.




Figure 2 The Emotional Support Network Density Analysis Form




Figure 3 Emotional Support in Social Network Diagram

The top three individuals in emotional support, with the highest external relationship centrality, can be found in A, I, and G in order.




Figure 4 The Informational Support Network Density Analysis Form

In Figure 4, there is only 0.39 social network density with a standard deviation of 0.488. Compare to emotional support there's a 0.08 disparity in social network density. As well as a 0.011 gap in the standard deviation of the relationship in the network between emotional and informational support.




Figure 5 Informational Support in Social Network Diagram
